Also Geography has been identified as one of 10 recession-proof degree subjects.

What is the course about?

- We offer the Edexcel Geography A Level course, which has three exams in Year 13 plus a project on any topic that you want to do.
- Paper 1: Tectonic Processes and Hazards, Coastal Landscapes, The Water Cycle and Water Insecurity, The Carbon Cycle and Energy Security.
- Paper 2: Globalisation, Superpowers, Regenerating Places, Health, Human Rights and Intervention.
- Paper 3: an issue-based synoptic paper drawing on all areas of the course.
- The course covers physical and human environments and the interactions between them.
