The aim of the programme is to help students make sure they are on track to achieving their career aspirations and that they are able to make informed decisions regarding their post-16 options.

In year 10, this will involve your child attending 4 sessions during school time at the London business The Maverick Group (5 Gainsford Street. London, SE1 2NE) on the 4th, 11th, 18th and the 25th March.

During those sessions your child will work with a business volunteer to:

- **Discover and explore careers** based on their strengths, interests, and motivations
- Research what **qualifications and skills** they need to achieve their top career
- Speak to **a professional** in the industry they are most interested in
- Build a career plan to turn their aspirations in to a reality

Two members of staff including Mr Young (Head of Year 10) will be accompanying the students to the business each week. They will leave Welling school at 10.00am to walk to Welling station and catch a train to London Bridge. Once there they will have a short walk to the business location.

They will aim to arrive back at Welling School for 3pm, but this is dependent on traffic and this means that students may be slightly late arriving back at school.
