Bexley Post-16 Directory 2021 - 2022


The directory of post-16 education in Bexley for the 2021 - 2022 academic year is now available. Along with the other information on our Decisions Post-16 web page, we hope it will help you make an informed decision on your next education steps.

COVID-19 means everyone is having to do things differently this year.

Many schools and colleges will be hosting their post-16 open events online, meaning you may need to pre-register to get the web links to take part. Dates of these events may also have to change depending on local COVID-19 restrictions.

We're putting the dates of the post-16 open events for each of our local providers on our website, along with the links to their website so you can sign-up. If a provider needs to change their date, we can then update our website with the latest information - helping to keep you informed.

We updated the Decisions Post-16 web page over the summer to include a better breakdown of our local providers by the type of qualifications they offer for post-16 study, along with a short video from the Department for Education that may help you decide which route is best for you. We've included links to provider websites so you can get further information on their offer, entry requirements and application process.
